Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, a lane shift will be completed on Friday, July 26, 2019, on the US 67 bridge repair project located between Rock Island and Milan. Traffic will be shifted to the west side of the completed bridges with one lane of traffic in each direction. Upon completion of the lane shift, Civil Constructors, Inc. will begin repairs on the east half of the bridges. Once the repairs on the east half are completed, all bridge deck surfaces will be ground for smoothness. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
