Havana bridge work begins Aug. 2

Lane closures will begin Aug. 5

HAVANA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work on the bridge that carries U.S. 136 over the Illinois River at Havana will begin Aug. 2.

The project will reduce the bridge to one lane controlled by flaggers during daylight hours starting Aug. 5, but closures may extend into the evening and nighttime hours. Westbound traffic may see long wait times during the lane closure. Work is expected to be complete by late August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
