Nightly, weekend lane closures on Skokie Highway

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the resurfacing of Skokie Highway (U.S. 41) from Lake Cook Road to Chantilly Lane, in Highland Park, will require nightly and weekend lane closures, as well as some daytime shoulder closures, starting, weather permitting, Monday, June 17.

In order to complete the work, lane closures will occur from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Concrete patching will be completed over three extended weekend lane closures, from 8 p.m. Fridays to 5 a.m. Mondays in July.

The project is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
