Repairs to Dundee Road over Edens

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that a bridge deck overlay as well as installation of new concrete abutments and expansion joints on Dundee Road (Illinois 68) over the Edens Expressway (Interstate 94), in Glencoe, will require permanent lane closures on Dundee Road and intermittent overnight lane closures on the expressway starting this week.

During the initial stage of construction, the outside lanes of Dundee Road will be closed in both directions. After the completion of the first stage in about six weeks, the inside lanes of Dundee Road will be closed in both directions for another six weeks. Intermittent overnight lane closures on the Edens will be required to allow for the placement of a protective shielding under the bridge.

The work is expected to be complete by mid-November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
