IL 160 in Madison County

HIGHLAND – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that IL 160 between Highland Road/Broadway in Highland and the Clinton County line will be intermittently restricted to one lane during daylight hours beginning on Wednesday, June 19, 2019, weather permitting. Two-way traffic will be maintained by the use of flaggers. This work is necessary to construct a new asphalt surface and is expected to be completed by the end of October.

Drivers are urged to reduce speed, be alert for changing conditions, obey all construction signage, and refrain from using mobile devices while approaching and traveling through the work zone.
