Washing of Michel bridge begins June 20

PEORIA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that washing of the Bob Michel Bridge, which carries Illinois 40 over the Illinois River, will begin Thursday, June 20.

Work will begin in the northbound lanes with daytime lane closures, and the southbound lanes will follow. Work in each direction is expected to last two days.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
