Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on I-88 eastbound, from the IL 78 interchange to the US 30 Clinton interchange, will begin on Monday, June 24, 2019. Martin and Co. Excavating will be starting the \$1.6 million contract to construct a bonded hot mix asphalt wearing surface on the eastbound lanes.

Eastbound lane closures will be required for approximately two months to complete the work, with all lanes open from 3 p.m. July 3 thru July 7.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
