Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on I-39 at Beemerville Road, located 3.0 miles south of US Route 30, will begin on Wednesday, June 26, 2019. Civil Coatings and Construction, Inc. will be starting the \$196,000 contract to clean and paint the steel on the structure carrying Beemerville Road over I-39.

To complete the work, lane closures will be required for I-39 northbound and southbound for approximately one month. Traffic on Beemerville Road will not be affected by the work.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
