Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, a lane shift on I-39 northbound between the I-88 and IL 38 interchanges will begin on Friday, June 28, 2019. The lane shift will be completed at night to avoid impacts to traffic during the shift. Crossovers north and south of the Creston Road overpass will be utilized for the lane shift, with concrete barrier wall separating the two northbound lanes and single southbound lane. Sjostrom & Sons, Inc. will then begin the repairs to the east span of the Creston Road overpass that was damaged by traffic.

The northbound crossovers will remain in effect for approximately six weeks to complete the bridge repairs. Creston Road will remain closed during the six weeks of repairs. I-88 traffic will not be affected by the lane shift.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
