PRESS RELEASE – LANE CLOSURE

*Interstate 70 westbound mile marker 39-32
Bond County*

Pocahontas – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces lane closures will be encountered on westbound Interstate 70 in the left lane, to implement pavement repairs, between mile marker 39 and 32. These lane closures will begin today, Thursday, June 6, and should continue until approximately Friday, June 28, 2019, weather permitting. This work is being completed by the Department’s Greenville Maintenance Yard.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
