## **Lane closures on U.S. 150 in Morton set June 24**

*Section of nearby bike path to be rerouted*

**MORTON** — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that daytime lane closures along U.S. 150 near Beverly Avenue in Morton will begin Monday, June 24.

The closures are necessary so that crews can reroute a portion of the River Trail of Illinois bike path around the section that is closed. The work is expected to last about four weeks.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
