Lane closures at Cumberland Circle in Des Plaines

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the reconstruction of the Cumberland Circle at Golf Road and North Wolf Road, in Des Plaines, will begin, weather permitting, Monday, March. 18.

The project consists of reconstructing the existing traffic circle into a modern roundabout. These improvements will reduce the footprint of the existing circle, provide a larger turn radius for trucks, add splitter islands directing vehicles into their proper lanes and introduce new overhead signage. In addition, the improvements will provide crosswalks on all five legs of the roundabout as well as improved drainage and lighting.

In order to complete the work, North Wolf Road and State Street will be closed in both directions at the circle and both legs of Golf Road reduced to one lane in each direction.

The project is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
