## Overnight closures on inbound I-190 and westbound Kennedy for sign removal and installation

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that as part of ongoing improvements to the Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90), intermittent, full closures will occur, weather permitting, to erect a new sign truss on eastbound Interstate 190 near the Chicago Transit Authority's Blue Line Rosemont station and to remove an existing overhead sign truss on the westbound Kennedy near Oriole Avenue.

The full closures on eastbound I-190 will occur starting at 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, March 12, through 4 a.m. on March 13. The full closures on the westbound Kennedy will occur between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. the week of March 18. The closures will last no more than 15 minutes at a time.

All lanes will remain open during daytime hours through the work zone.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
