79th Street frontage lane closures in Chicago

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that repairs to the bridge carrying 79th Street over the CSX Railroad, in Chicago, will require daily lane closures on the frontage road, weather permitting, Monday, Mar. 25.

The project consists of structural steel and beam repairs as well as the rehabilitation of a retaining wall. During the day, the frontage road will be reduced to a single lane.

The work is expected to be complete by the end of May.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
