Nightly lane closures on Skokie Highway

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that the resurfacing of Skokie Highway (U.S. 41) from West Park Avenue in Highland Park to Belvidere Road (Illinois 120) in Park City will require nightly lane closures and daytime shoulder closures starting, weather permitting, April 8.

In order to complete the work, the southbound lanes will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., with the northbound lanes closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. The work is expected to be complete by the end of November.

Motorists also should anticipate intermittent daytime lane closures on northbound Skokie Highway for culvert repairs throughout the month of April. Additionally, Half Day Road (Illinois 22) in Highland Park in the vicinity of Skokie Highway will be reduced to one lane in each direction during April for patching repairs.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
