Culvert work along U.S. 150 begins April 2

CHAMPAIGN — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work along U.S. 150 between Champaign and Mahomet will resume Tuesday, April 2.

The project involves three culvert replacements in the following locations:

- Finishing work at Staley Road and U.S. 150, begins April 2
- Near Rising Road, begins April 8
- East of Staley, begins April 15

The culverts will be replaced in a continuous operation to minimize traffic disruption. After each replacement, lane closures will be necessary for about six weeks to complete paving and other minor work.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
