Pavement patching set April 1 for I-39, 74

BLOOMINGTON — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that pavement patching on Interstate 39 and Interstate 74 will begin Monday, April 1.

The work zone on I-39 is at Normal north to the Woodford County line, and on I-74 southwest of Bloomington. The patching will require lane closures with at least one lane open in each direction during the project, which is expected to be completed by the end of April, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
