Work on Farmington Road to begin week of March 18

Bridge replacement, intersection improvements on tap

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Farmington Road over Kickapoo Creek will begin the week of Monday, March 18, weather permitting.

The work involves removal and replacement of the bridge that carries Farmington Road over the creek, relocating the intersection of Farmington and Kickapoo Creek roads, and widening and resurfacing Farmington Road on both sides of the intersection. The project is expected to be complete by fall 2020.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
