## Work on I-74 near Brimfield set March 26

**BRIMFIELD** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work near the bridges that carry Interstate 74 over French Creek, about 7 miles west of Brimfield, will begin Tuesday, March 26.

The project involves drilling soil borings in the left and right shoulders of the east- and westbound lanes near each bridge. To facilitate the work, the westbound side will be reduced to one lane for the first two days, and then the eastbound side will be reduced to one lane the next two days. Work will begin at about 8 a.m. each day and end at about 4:30 p.m., and is expected to be completed by Friday, March 29.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
