Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on US 67 between Milan and Rock Island will begin on Friday, March 22, 2019. Civil Constructors, Inc. will be starting the \$8.7 million contract to complete structural steel and bridge deck repairs to the three bridges carrying US 67 over the Rock River between Milan and Rock Island.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction for the duration of the project. Access for residents and to all businesses within the project limits will be maintained at all times. The project is scheduled to be completed by late November of 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
