Work on U.S. 24 bridge in Eureka begins April 1

EUREKA — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work on the bridge that carries U.S. 24 over Walnut Creek in Eureka begins Monday, April 1.

The work will require lane closures, with one-way traffic maintained by temporary signals, and is expected to be completed in September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
