## Nighttime work over I-57 to resume June 3

*Crews removing Bradley Avenue bridge*

CHAMPAIGN — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that nighttime work in [the Bradley Avenue bridge work zone](#) over Interstate 57 will resume Monday, June 3.

The project involves removing the existing bridge, which will require a lane closure with traffic control devices. Intermittent closures of the other lane will be done using a rolling road block in coordination with the Illinois State Police and will last about 25 minutes at a time. The work will be done between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and is expected to last eight nights.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
