## **Lane closures on Interstate 74 begin June 3**

**CHAMPAIGN** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that lane closures on Interstate 74 between Duncan and Lindsay roads will begin Monday, June 3.

The closures are necessary so that crews can paint the bridges carrying Duncan and Lindsay roads over I-74. The first work zone will be in the eastbound lanes, which is expected to last three to four weeks. Work will then switch to the westbound lanes, which also is expected to take about three to four weeks. One lane will remain open at all times during the work.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
