I-255 in Monroe County

Columbia – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that I-255 between the Jefferson Barracks Bridge and Illinois Route 3 near Columbia will be restricted to one lane in each direction beginning Monday, May 13, 2019, weather permitting. These restrictions will take place daily between the hours of 6:00 PM and 6:00 AM. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs and is expected to be completed by Friday, May 17, 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
