## Bond Avenue in St. Clair County

**Alorton** – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that Bond Avenue in St. Clair County from 37<sup>th</sup> Street to 41<sup>st</sup> Street will be closed beginning Monday, May 6, 2019, weather permitting. Message boards will be in place to move traffic around the closure. This closure is required to make repairs to the bridge over the Alton/Southern Railroad. This work is expected to be completed by the end of July 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to the detour signs, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

The contractor on this project is Keeley and Sons, Inc., from East St. Louis, Illinois.
