IL 127 near Carlyle in Clinton County

CARLYLE – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL 127 over the middle tributary of Flat Branch Creek, 1.2 miles south of the Bond County Line, will be restricted to one lane beginning Tuesday, June 11, 2019, weather permitting. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using temporary traffic signals. This work is necessary to complete culvert repairs and is expected to be completed by late August 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.

The contractor on this project is Stutz Excavating, Inc., of Alton, Illinois.
