Eastbound I-74 in Morton to close May 2

Crews to remove overturned semi in work zone

MORTON — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that eastbound Interstate 74 will close at exit 102 (Morton Avenue) on Thursday, May 2.

The closure is necessary to remove an overturned semitrailer from the work zone along I-74. The interstate will close at 10 p.m. for approximately four hours. Eastbound traffic will be detoured at exit 102 and use U.S. 150 through Morton and get back on I-74 at Goodfield.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
