## Traffic signal work in Pekin set May 15

**PEKIN** — The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that traffic signal modifications at the intersection of Third and Margaret streets (Illinois 9/29) in Pekin will begin Wednesday, May 15.

The work involves relocating the traffic signal control cabinet and replacing the signal heads. Traffic will be controlled by temporary stop signs during the work, which will begin at 8:30 a.m. and is expected to be complete by 3:30 p.m.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
