Bob Michel Bridge inspection begins Oct. 21

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that a routine inspection of the Bob Michel Bridge, which carries Illinois 40 over the Illinois River at Peoria, is set for Oct. 21 and 22.

The inspection will require lane closures, beginning with the northbound side down to one lane Oct. 21. The southbound side will be down to one lane Oct. 22.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
