PRESS RELEASE – IL 160 UPDATE

*ALL lanes closed 2.7 miles south of IL 140 in Madison County
Extended to September 27*

Grantfork– The Illinois Department of Transportation announces **ALL lanes of IL 160, approximately 2.7 miles south of IL 140 near Grantfork in Madison County, will remain closed until September 27, 2019** for the repairs being made to the culvert at this location, weather permitting. A detour utilizing IL 140, IL 4, and IL 143 is established for the IL 160 closure. Keeley and Sons Inc. is the contractor performing the repairs.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
