Illinois 176 resurfacing begins April 20

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that resurfacing of Illinois 176 from Crescent Knoll Drive, in Libertyville, to just west of U.S. 41, in Lake Bluff, will require daytime and nighttime lane closures with flaggers, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 20.

The project, which consists of patching and resurfacing the 2.6 mile stretch of Illinois 176, constructing new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps and replacing deteriorated curbs, is expected to be completed in September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
