I-80 bridge work at Peru begins April 27

PERU – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Interstate 80 between Illinois 251 (exit 75) and I-39 (exits 79A-B) begins April 27.

The work involves replacement of the deck and beams on the bridges that carry I-80 over the Little Vermilion River as well as repairs to the bridges over Raccuglia Drive and East Third Road. All ramps at the Illinois 351 interchange (exit 77) will remain open during construction, which is expected to be complete in fall 2021.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
