## **Harlem Avenue resurfacing begins March 1**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the second phase of resurfacing of Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) from 171<sup>st</sup> Street, in Tinley Park to just north of 159<sup>th</sup> Street (U.S. 6), in Orland Park, will require daily lane closures with flaggers beginning, weather permitting, March 1.

The project, which consists of resurfacing Harlem Avenue, constructing new ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and replacing deteriorated curbs, is expected to be completed by July.

Harlem Avenue between U.S. 30 and 171<sup>st</sup> Street was resurfaced in November 2019.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
