U.S. 20 resurfacing begins this week

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that starting this week a resurfacing of U.S. 20 (Elgin Bypass) from Plank Road, in Plato Township, to Shales Parkway/Bluff City Blvd., in Elgin, will require daily, intermittent lane closures.

The project, which consists of patching and resurfacing the 7.4-mile stretch of U.S. 20, is expected to be completed in September. Access to residences and businesses within the work zone will be maintained throughout construction.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
