I-55 and I-55/70 in Madison County

Troy/Edwardsville/Hamel – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced intermittent closures on I-55 and I-55/70, from 1 mile north of Livingston to the US 40, beginning on Monday evening at 6:00 PM, June 8, 2020, weather permitting. These closures will take place during both night and day but all lanes will be open between 6:00 AM and 9:00 AM in the northbound direction and between 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM in the southbound direction. This work is necessary to do pavement repairs and is expected to be complete by June 12, 2020.

Drivers may experience delays when traveling through the work zone. Drivers are urged to reduce speed, be alert for changing conditions, obey all construction signage, and refrain from using mobile devices while approaching and traveling through the work zone.
