IL 37 from 0.5 Mile South of Cross Street to the Jefferson County Line in Marion County

Salem – The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that IL 37 from 0.5 mile south of Cross Street to the Jefferson County Line will be intermittently restricted to one lane beginning Monday, June 22, 2020, weather permitting. This work will take place daily between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Traffic in each direction will be maintained using flaggers. This work is necessary to complete pavement repairs, construct safety shoulders, and complete asphalt resurfacing. Work is expected to be completed by early September 2020.

Motorists should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to construction signage and watch for changing conditions, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment while approaching and traveling through the work zone.

The contractor on this project is Howell Paving, Inc. of Mattoon, Illinois.
