### *LANE REDUCTIONS*

#### *IL 34*

#### *HARDIN COUNTY*

The Illinois Department of Transportation would like to alert motorists traveling on IL 34 of upcoming LANE REDUCTIONS.

Beginning Monday, June 29, 2020, weather permitting, there will be road construction work on IL 34 from the Pope/Hardin County Line to just north of IL 146 that will require lane closures beginning at 7am. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and controlled by flaggers. Work includes pavement patching, asphalt surface removal, asphalt paving and pavement markings. The work is expected to be completed by October 16, 2020. Motorists should reduce speed, be alert to equipment and workers and use extreme caution while traveling through all work zones.

To avoid any delays motorists should seek an alternate route. Emergency vehicles will be allowed through the work zone as quickly as possible.
