## **I-74 work begins June 22**

*Lane closures from Mahomet to Mansfield*

**MAHOMET** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that construction on Interstate 74 between Mahomet and Mansfield begins June 22.

The project involves pavement patching and resurfacing and will require lane closures, with one lane open in each direction at all times. Work is expected to be complete in about 10 weeks, weather permitting.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
