Illinois 116 resurfacing begins June 15

ROSEVILLE – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that resurfacing of Illinois 116 from the Knox County line to Township Road 154 (115th Street), about 2 miles south of the Massasauga Prairie Nature Preserve in Warren County, begins June 15.

The work will require intermittent daytime lane closures and is expected to be complete in August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
