OTTAWA, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the IL 49–Union Pacific Railroad grade crossing in Cissna Park will be closed on Tuesday, June 23, 2020. IL 49 will be closed for approximately seven days to allow the Union Pacific Railroad to remove their grade crossings, patch the voids with asphalt and perform necessary highway approach work. IL 49 traffic will proceed as follows:

IL 49 northbound traffic will proceed east on County Highway 10 to IL 1; thence north on IL 1 to W Jones Street (County Highway 9 Extension); thence west on W Jones Street which turns into County Highway 9 back to IL 49.

IL 49 southbound traffic will proceed east on County Highway 9 which turns into W Jones Street to IL 1; thence south on IL 1 to County Highway 10; thence west on County Highway 10 back to IL 49.

Motorists are urged to use caution and expect some delays while traveling the detour route. Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
