Lighting project at two interchanges

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that new light poles and light towers will be installed at the Interstate 290 / Illinois 53 interchange with Interstate 90 (Jane Addams Memorial Tollway) interchange, in Rolling Meadows and at the Interstate 57 and U.S. 30 interchange, in Matteson.

In order to complete the work, both interchanges will have daily shoulder closures with occasional lane closures. The operation will take place during regular daytime hours, with minimal impacts on the peak morning and afternoon travel periods.

The work in Rolling Meadows is starting this week. The Matteson location will begin, weather permitting, the week of March 16.

Both locations are expected to be complete by early November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
