Higgins Road resurfacing begins April 6

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that resurfacing of Higgins Road (Illinois 72) from Commonwealth Drive to Glen Lake Road, in Hoffman Estates, passing through South Barrington and Schaumburg, will require daily, intermittent lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 6.

In addition, motorists can also expect periodic overnight lane closures at the Sutton Road (Illinois 59) and Higgins Road intersection. During that time, one lane in each direction will be maintained.

The project, which consists of resurfacing the 8-mile stretch of Higgins Road, constructing new ADA-compliant sidewalk ramps and replacing deteriorated curbs, is expected to be completed in November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
