LANE REDUCTIONS

I-24

MASSAC COUNTY

The Illinois Department of Transportation would like to alert motorists traveling the Southbound/Eastbound Lanes of I-24 in Massac County of upcoming LANE REDUCTIONS.

Beginning Monday, March 30, 2020, weather permitting, there will be road construction work on the Southbound/Eastbound Lanes of I-24 in Massac County that will require lane closures beginning at 7am. Traffic will be reduced to one lane. Work is expected to last for three weeks. Work includes patching the centerline and pavement markings. Motorists should reduce speed, be alert to equipment and workers and use extreme caution while traveling through all work zones.

To avoid any delays motorists should seek an alternate route.
