Illinois 29 work begins May 4

Resurfacing between Rochester and Berry

ROCHESTER – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that resurfacing of Illinois 29 between Cardinal Hill Road in Rochester and Jett Road at Berry begins May 4.

At least one lane will be open in each direction during the resurfacing, which will help preserve the road and provide a smoother driving surface. Work is expected to last about a month.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
