Kennedy bridge inspection Sunday near Addison Street

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a routine bridge inspection of the Kennedy Expressway (Interstate 90/94) near Addison Street, in Chicago, will require moving lane closures, weather permitting, from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m., Sunday, Oct. 11.

In order to complete the inspection, two-lane moving closures will be utilized in both directions of the expressway's local lanes. A minimum of two lanes will be open at all times.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the next six years, IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,300 miles of highway and 8.4 million square feet of bridge deck as part of the Rebuild Illinois capital program, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. Year One included approximately \$2.7 billion of improvements statewide on 1,706 miles of highway, 128 bridges and 228 additional safety improvements.
