Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work will begin on Monday, November 2, 2020, on the bridge carrying I-88 over the Rock River near Rock Falls. Civil Constructors, Inc. will be starting the \$270,000 project for maintenance upgrades to the drainage components at the expansion joints.

Most of the project will be completed from underneath the structure without affecting traffic. However, intermittent lane closures may be required to complete the project, which is scheduled to be completed by the end of November.

To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
