IL 4 (PINE STREET) IN PERCY IN RANDOLPH COUNTY TO BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED *CLOSURE NECESSARY FOR ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY TO REHABILITATE ITS CROSSING*

PERCY – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that, weather permitting, IL 4 (Pine Street) from 2nd Street to 3rd Street in Percy in Randolph County will be closed for rehabilitative work of the railroad crossing on Monday, November 16, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. and continuing until Friday, November 20, 2020, at 3:00 p.m. Both lanes will be closed. A marked detour will be in place to safely guide motorists around the closure.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
