I-74 work in Peoria County begins Sept. 8

PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that construction on Interstate 74 west of Peoria begins Sept. 8.

The project involves pavement patching, resurfacing, and drainage improvements from Kickapoo (exit 82) to just east of the I-474 interchange (exits 87A-B). I-74 will be reduced to one lane in each direction during the work, which is expected to be complete in November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
