Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, the northbound ramp of I-39 at US 20 will be closed to allow for the construction of the ramp, outside lane of US 20, including the shoulder, and the ramp connectors. The closure is scheduled to last until September 22, 2020.

Message boards and detour signs will be placed in advance to notify the traveling public of the closures. I-39 northbound traffic should follow detour signs utilizing US 20 eastbound to the Harrison Avenue Interchange.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. To avoid the work area, when feasible, use of alternate routes should be considered. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to changed conditions and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, refrain from using mobile devices and be alert for workers and equipment.
