Westbound U.S. 30 Reduced to One Lane in Lynwood

CHICAGO - The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that westbound U.S. 30 in Lynwood will be reduced to one lane next week at the CN Railroad crossing just west of the state line for the installation of temporary signals to warn traffic of approaching trains. Both eastbound lanes will remain open while one westbound lane is closed from Monday, Oct. 20, until Friday, Oct. 24.

The temporary signals will be in place to accommodate the work zone needed for construction of a new bridge carrying U.S. 30 over the CN Railroad tracks. The \$29.6 million bridge project started this summer, with an anticipated completion date in late 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
